• Two Rivers Landing, Easton, PA

- Located at what the Lenni Lenape Indians knew as the “Forks of the Delaware”, the city of Easton sits on the banks where the Lehigh and Delaware rivers merge. This is why Easton’s Centre Square is called Two Rivers Landing.
